1,000 Dreams Fund Announces Its Fall 2017 Scholarship Recipients

\$10,000 Granted Out By Non-Profit & Their Student-Led Scholarship Review Committee

Washington D.C., 9/1/2017 -The 1,000 Dreams Fund (1DF), a national scholarship fund which provides microgrant funding to American girls in high school and college, announced today its 2017 fall scholarship recipients.

Out of over 400 applications, 10 girls were chosen by the organization's student-led scholarship review committee based on their outstanding academic track records, their desire to be a change agent in their community and proof of financial need.

A total of \$10,000 is being granted out with each recipient receiving a \$1,000 microgrant towards their college costs this fall. Unlike other scholarship funds, 1DF's mission is to fund the "extras", the outside-of-the-classroom experiences and expenses that often go unfunded.

"We're are thrilled to announce our fall scholarship recipients. These young women are all role models and exhibit a true passion for their community" said Christie Garton, founder and CEO of the 1,000 Dreams Fund. "We are deeply committed to helping talented young women in need achieve their goals by funding those extra costs that help make their dream a reality."

The 1,000 Dreams Fund offers American girls in high school or college the opportunity to apply for scholarship funding twice per year with up to \$1,000 in funding available.
